## Fours & Fives Class

### September

Children's Catechism Q. 1 – 3

Philippians 2: 14 "Do all things without grumbling or questioning, . . ."

1 Corinthians 15: 33 "Do not be deceived: 'Bad company ruins good morals.'"

Children's Catechism Q. 4 – 6

Romans 12: 21 "Do not be overcome by evil, but overcome evil with good."

Children's Catechism Q. 7 – 9

1 John 4: 19 "We love because he first loved us."

### September

Children's Catechism Q. 1 – 3

1 Peter 5: 7 "...casting all your anxieties on him, because he cares for you."

Philippians 4: 19 "And my God will supply every need of yours according to his riches in glory in Christ Jesus."

### October

Children's Catechism Q. 4 – 6

1 John 3: 16a "By this we know love, that he laid down his life for us, . . ."

1 Thessalonians 5: 11 "Therefore encourage one another and build one other up, just as you are doing."

### November

Children's Catechism Q. 7 – 9

1 John 4: 10 "In this is love, not that we have loved God but that he loved us and sent his Son to be the propitiation for our sins. "

James 4: 17 "So whoever knows the right thing to do and fails to do it, for him it is sin."

## First & Second Grade Class

### September

Children's Catechism Q. 42 – 45

James 1: 19, 20 "Know this, my beloved brothers: let every person be quick to hear, slow to speak, slow to anger; for the anger of man does not produce the righteousness that God requires."

1 John 5: 2 "By this we know that we love the children of God, when we love God and obey his commandments."

### October

Children's Catechism Q. 46 – 48

2 Timothy 2: 15 "Do your best to present yourself to God as one approved, a worker who has no need to be ashamed, rightly handling the word of truth."

2 Corinthians 7: 10 "For godly grief produces a repentance that leads to salvation without regret, whereas worldly grief produces death."

### November

Children's Catechism Q. 49 – 51

Ephesians 4: 29 "Let no corrupting talk come out of your mouths, but only such as is good for building up, as fits the occasion, that it may give grace to those who hear."

Colossians 1: 15 "He is the image of the invisible God, the firstborn of all creation."

## Third & Fourth Grade Class

### September

Children's Catechism Q. 97 – 100

Philippians 4: 6, 7 ". . .do not be anxious about anything, but in everything by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known to God. And the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus."

1 Timothy 4: 9, 10 "The saying is trustworthy and deserving of full acceptance. For to this end we toil and strive, because we have our hope set on the living God, who is the Savior of all people, especially of those who believe."

### October

Children's Catechism Q. 101 – 104

1 Corinthians 6: 19, 20 "Or do you not know that your body is a temple of the Holy Spirit within you, whom you have from God? You are not your own, for you were bought with a price. So glorify God in your body."

### November

Children's Catechism Q. 105 – 107

1 Peter 2: 24 "He himself bore our sins in his body on the tree, so that we might die to sin and live to righteousness. By his wounds you have been healed."

James 1: 2, 3 "Count it all joy, my brothers, when you meet trials of various kinds, for you know that the testing of your faith produces steadfastness."

## **Fifth & Sixth Grade Class**

### **September**

Shorter Catechism Q. 1 – 4

Hebrews 1: 1 - 3 "Long ago, at many times and in many ways, God spoke to our fathers by the prophets, but in these last days he has spoken to us by his Son, whom he appointed the heir of all things, through whom also he created the world. He is the radiance of the glory of God and the exact imprint of his nature, and he upholds the universe by the word of his power. After making purification for sins, he sat down at the right hand of the Majesty on high, . . ."

### **October**

Shorter Catechism Q. 5 – 8

James 2: 18, 19 "But someone will say, 'You have faith and I have works.' Show me your faith apart from your works, and I will show you my faith by my works. You believe that God is one; you do well. Even the demons believe – and shudder!"

### **November**

Shorter Catechism Q. 9 – 13

Hebrews 13: 15, 16 "Through him (Jesus) then let us continually offer up a sacrifice of praise to God, that is, the fruit of lips that acknowledge his name. Do not neglect to do good and to share what you have, for such sacrifices are pleasing to God."

## **Seventh & Eighth Grade Class**

### **September**

Shorter Catechism Q. 82 – 85

Philippians 2: 5 - 11 "Have this mind among yourselves, which is yours in Christ Jesus, who, though he was in the form of God, did not count equality with God a thing to be grasped, but made himself nothing, taking the form of a servant, being born in the likeness of men. And being found in human form, he humbled himself by becoming obedient to the point of death, even death on a cross. Therefore God has highly exalted him and bestowed on him the name that is above every name, so that at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, in heaven and on earth and under the earth, and every tongue confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father."

### **October**

Shorter Catechism Q. 86 - 89

Philippians 2: 14 - 16 "Do all things without grumbling or questioning, that you may be blameless and innocent, children of God without blemish in the midst of a crooked and twisted generation, among whom you shine as lights in

the world, holding fast to the word of life, so that in the day of Christ I may be proud that I did not run or labor in vain.”

## **November**

Shorter Catechism Q. 90 – 93

Galatians 2: 20 “I have been crucified with Christ. It is no longer I who live, but Christ who lives in me. And the life I now live in the flesh I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave himself for me.”

Romans 15: 1, 2 “We who are strong have an obligation to bear with the failings of the weak, and not to please ourselves. Let each of us please his neighbor for his good, to build him up.”
